

# 2026 Comprehensive Guide: Event Licensing & Permits in India

## Introduction

Planning a corporate event in 2026 involves more than just a great venue and a theme. In India, especially in metros like Mumbai, legal compliance is the backbone of a successful event. This guide simplifies the complex web of NOCs and licenses required to ensure your event stays on the right side of the law.

## 1. The "Music & Entertainment" Cluster

If you have a DJ, a live band, or even background music, these three are non-negotiable.

- **IPRS (Indian Performing Right Society):** Covers the "underlying works" (lyrics and music composition). Mandatory for live singers and bands.
- **PPL (Phonographic Performance Ltd):** Covers the "sound recording." Mandatory if you are playing recorded tracks via a DJ or laptop.
- **Novex Communications:** Required specifically for labels like Yash Raj, Zee, and Eros.
- **Rangayan (Performance License):** Specifically required in Maharashtra for any public performance, play, or musical show.

## 2. The "Safety & Security" Cluster (NOCs)

These are issued by local government bodies to ensure the physical safety of your guests.

- **Police NOC:** Mandatory for any large gathering. It covers security, crowd control, and the "loudspeaker permit" (usually valid until 10:00 PM).
- **Traffic NOC:** Required if your event expects a high volume of cars that might impact public roads (common for venues in **BKC** or **Worli**).
- **Fire Brigade NOC (Form B):** Essential if you are building temporary structures, stages, or using heavy electrical equipment.

### 3. The "Logistics & Hospitality" Cluster

- **One-Day Excise Permit (FL-4):** Mandatory if alcohol is served. Even for "private" corporate invites, you must have this to avoid heavy fines or event closure.
  - **Electrical/PWD License:** Required if you are using external generators (Gen-sets) to power your AV and lighting.
  - **Health & Food License:** Usually covered by the venue, but if you bring an outside caterer, they must have a valid FSSAI certificate for the event.

License Type	Timeline	Responsibility
Premises/Venue Booking	3-6 Months	Client / Agency
Police & Traffic NOC	21 Days Before	Event Agency
Music Licenses (PPL/IPRS)	7 Days Before	Event Agency
One-Day Liquor Permit	5 Days Before	Client / Venue
Fire NOC (Form B)	10 Days Before	Technical Team

### Expert Tips from MRG Events

1. **Don't Assume the Venue Handles It:** Most hotels only provide the space. The permits for *what happens* inside that space (music, alcohol, extra staging) are almost always the organizer's responsibility.
2. **The 10 PM Rule:** In Mumbai, sound deadlines are strictly enforced. Plan your "High Energy" segments before 9:45 PM to allow for a smooth wind-down.
3. **Digital Documentation:** Always keep a digital folder of all approved NOCs on your phone. Authorities may visit the site for a spot-check.
